DESIGN WORKSHOP ON PROPOSED BALLPARK AND ADJACENT DEVELOPMENT ANNOUNCED

The Nashville Civic Design Center will hold a workshop on Thursday, December 15, 2005 from 12:30 – 2:30 p.m. at the Downtown Public Library to gather public input on the design of the baseball park and mixed use development being proposed for the site of the former Thermal Transfer Plant in downtown Nashville. The Downtown Public Library is located at 615 Church Street.

Representatives of the Sounds and their development and design team as well as representatives of Struever Bros. Eccles and Rouse will be present to discuss various design issues including the size, scale and location of the various components of the development as well as the orientation of the baseball park.

The design workshop was first suggested at a public meeting convened by the Nashville Civic Design Center held on August 25, 2005. The Sounds baseball team owners and Struever Bros. Eccles and Rouse committed at that time to further engage Nashvillians in the design process associated with planning and building the proposed ballpark and adjacent mixed-use (retail and residential) development.
